### RECIPE OF THE MONTH

### **Oatmeal Scotchies Cookies**

1 ¼ Cups flour
1 tsp. baking soda
½ tsp salt
½ tsp cinnamon
1 cup unsalted butter
softened
¾ cupsugar
¾ cup firmly packed brown
sugar
2 eggs
1 tsp vanilla

1 tsp vanilla3 cups oats uncooked12 oz bag Butterscotch chips

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Line baking sheets with parchment. In a bowl combine flour, baking soda, salt, and cinnamon, set aside. In another bowl, beat butter, sugars, eggs, & vanilla until creamy. Gradually add flour mixture. Stir in oats and butterscotch chips. Drop by level tblsp. Bake 7-8 minutes for chewy cookies, 9-10 minutes for crispy. Cool completely on wire racks.


