FROM THE BOARD **Recreational Vehicles** Per the CCR&R's 4.3 VEHICLES. For the period commencing one (1) week after Labor Day extending to one (1) week before Memorial Day, no recreational vehicle and/or commercial vehicle, including but not limited to boats, campers, motor homes, trucks in excess of one (1) ton, and trailers – whether operable or not – of any kind shall be parked, stored, maintained or constructed on any Lot or street in such a manner to be visible from the street or neighboring lots, except that portion extending above the maximum height of the required fence. Recreation vehicles and/or commercial vehicles parked behind a fence is considered acceptable.

That being said, as of Monday, May 21st, homeowners may now have recreational vehicles and boats parked on their aggregate driveways or approved gravel/stone side driveways.
