#### RECIPEOFTHEMONTH

#### Ranch Pasta & Potato Salad

#### **SALAD**

6 small (new) red potatoes, unpeeled, cut into ½- inch cubes (2 cups)

6 oz. (2 ¼ cups uncooked rainbow rotini (spiral pasta)

8 slices bacon, cut into ½ -inch pieces ½ cup chopped red bell pepper ¼ cup chopped green onions DRESSING

½ cup mayonnaise or salad dressing ½ cup purchased ranch salad dressing


Bring about 10 cups water to a boil in a 4-quart pan. Reduce heat to medium-high. Add potatoes; cook 3 minutes. Add rotini; return to a boil. Cook potatoes and rotini an additional 10-12 or until tender. Drain; rinse with cold water to cool. Drain well. Meanwhile cook bacon until crisp. Drain on paper towels. In a large bowl, combine cooked potatoes and rotini, cooked bacon, bell pepper and green onions. In a small bowl, combine dressing ingredients; blend well. Add to salad; toss to coat. Cover; refrigerate at least 1 hour or until serving time.
